THE BOOK OF EPHESIANS

<u>Goal</u>

To become a Christ-Centered Church; to experience Christ in a fresh way and to become excited about being in a relationship with Him alone; to get students to open their hearts to Christ and allow Him to fill every void in their lives, to satisfy them completely; to create an "In Christ Alone" climate

Objectives:

- 1. Attend as many class sessions as possible. Participate in the class discussions. DO ALL HOMEWORK!!!
- 2. To know and understand WHY the book of Ephesians was written
- 3. Read the book of Ephesians as often as you can throughout this period (Jan-June). Let's see who reads it most. (Be sure to keep a log.)
- 4. Everywhere in this book you see *in*, *with*, *through* Christ (and any other like prepositions), record and write your response to it. For example, Ephesians 1:1 states: "Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, to the saints which are at Ephesus and to the faithful <u>IN</u> <u>CHRIST JESUS</u>." In this case, you would record the verse and then give your response to what that means to you personally. You could say, "I

see here that the Lord identifies faithfulness through one's abiding in Christ. He expects His children to be faithful in Christ alone."

- 5. Record what you hear the Spirit say to you as you read the book.
- 6. Discuss how you see your life changing (becoming more reflective of Christ) as you read Ephesians.
- 7. To refamiliarize yourself with all the components of the spiritual armor as listed in the 6th chapter; to list them and thoroughly explain each part
- 8. Which part(s) do you think you are having more problems with? Why?
- 9. Which part(s) do you feel you are succeeding in? Why?
- 10. Define Spiritual Warfare
- 11. Give strategies you've used in spiritual warfare. Discuss at least three of your spiritual warfare experiences (for your personal use. You may share ONLY if you'd like.) The point here is to make sure you understand what spiritual warfare is and how to effectively engage, according to the Word of God.
- 12. Locate, define and understand the following terms as they are used in Ephesians: Apostles, Church, Circumcision, Dominion, Evangelists, Faith, Forgiveness, Grace, Holiness, Lasciviousness, Mercy, Might, Pastors, Power(s), Prophets, Quickened, Prayer, Principality, Redemption, Righteousness, Salvation, Supplication, and Teachers
- 13. Include any other terms you would like. Create an Ephesians dictionary, if you would like. Just have a wonderful time exploring this wonderful gift to us, the book of Ephesians, which perfectly captures, "In Christ Alone!"
